**Reopening Day Plan Update**

Dr. Kevin Myers, superintendent, reviewed the district reopening day plan. He shared the guiding principles for the district. He also reviewed various areas that included information from the CDC, the impact of an outbreak, community transmission, and how the district compares to the CDC transmission rates.
