Re: Home football games at Mundelein High School and our Homecoming game Friday, September 27 vs Libertyville High School. The football game will Kick off at 7 p.m. The gates will open for entry at 6 p.m.

Entry and exit from the stadium will happen at the main ticket gate or the visiting ticket gate only. The home gate is located on the southwest side of the stadium and the visiting gate is on the northwest side of the stadium. There will be no Re-Entry once a person exits the stadium.

At our home football game last week there were a large number of younger (middle school aged and younger) children playing unsupervised. We are going to institute a policy for our remaining Home Football Games where non-high-school-aged children will not be allowed into the stadium without a supervising adult. There will be a limit of five children with one supervising adult who will be responsible for the children.

Mundelein High School is reminding our parents/guardians and students that we have a list of items that we do not allow into the stadium on game days. Disallowed items that are not allowed in the stadium are backpacks, large purses, beach bags, outside coolers, outside food or drink, noise makers, balls, inflatable toys, laser pointers, paint, baby powder, streamers, alcoholic beverages, tobacco of any kind including e-cigarettes, drones (except for MHS School Issued Drones), pets. If someone has these items they will be confiscated at the entry gates.

Permitted items that are allowed are sealed water bottles, carried rain gear, baby food, blankets, coats, and umbrellas, wheelchairs and walkers, service dogs trained to aid patrons with a disability and pre approved signs or posters.

A lanyard is required to enter the inside gates that give access to the track or vip seating area. Anyone without a lanyard **worn will** not be allowed to enter the VIP seating area.

We hope to see you at our Homecoming game on Friday and want to provide a welcoming atmosphere for everyone.
