Booster Funds

There was a discussion on how the booster group could distribute some additional funds for the band program. Items will be discussed further at meetings later in the school year. The boosters discussed and approved the following:

When a band student participates in individual fundraising opportunities (Scrip, Fannie May, Pie Cards, Citrus Sale) 80% of the fundraising profits are added to the student's escrow account and 20% is added to the band booster's account.

Due to this being a trip year, the boosters have announced that 100% of the fundraising profits will be added to the student escrow accounts. The boosters will not receive their 20% of the profits. This will run from September 1, 2018 through March 31, 2019. Starting in April, the boosters will resume the 80% to escrow accounts and 20% to booster account split.

Remember, funds from escrow accounts can be used for travel with the band as well as private ilessons, instrument purchase/repair/rental/supplies, summer music camps, and/or audition fees.
