Uniforms (Maureen Casler)

Fundraising (Chair Needed):

- Scrips purchases went up in December; maybe we should consider sending out an email prior to the holidays to make sure people can order in time
- Fannie Mae will start February 14. The students will have 2-3 weeks to sell. Chocolates will arrive in March and will already be presorted. This is a fairly easy fundraiser to run.

Hospitality (Lynn Owens)

Concert Band Clinic night – We will need food for the two honors bands and clinicians. We provided
Jimmy Johns last year for the clinicians and pizza for the students. The numbers will be similar to that of
the All Star's night. Lynn will send out emails for volunteers to help with the clinic night.

Directors Updates:

- This is going to be a busy month for Jazz Band. There was a Facebook post that highlighted the HJE being selected for the state festival (IMEC). We've been working with the district's graphic designer for the IMEC handout. The school will pay for the design cost and ½ of printing cost, will the boosters pay for the other ½ of printing cost (\$645)? Jim Hoferitza made a motion, seconded by Jack Sikora to pay the cost and all present agreed.
- In preparation for IMEC we had a clinician yesterday
- Directors asked for the boosters to pay for a celebratory meal for the students @ Alexander's after the IMEC festival, which will be approximately \$600. Boosters approved.
- BIG NEWS: The school board approved the purchase of marching band uniforms. First round sketch was
 provided for boosters to review and an initial sample uniform will be made and shown to us in about a
 month. Once we finalize the design the department chair will put in an order. There will be improvements
 in the look and functionality, e.g. color distinctions in sleeves and front/back, all hems will have snaps and
 will no longer require sewing. We will likely donate the old uniforms once the new ones are in hand.

Miscellaneous:

- Ladder signs were delivered and Jack Sikora presented them to the Boosters.
- Kristine Asmussen suggested that for future band programs we should make sure to mention the Silent Auction at the Evening of Jazz.
- Julie Salski noted that for the incoming Freshmen Class selection sheet the choir option reads as if band is not an option for choir students which should be corrected
- Directors will reach out to middle school band directors to confirm dates for spring concerts that they want Boosters to host informational tables. Once we get the dates, Serena Moon will email all boosters present at today's meeting to find volunteers who can host tables
