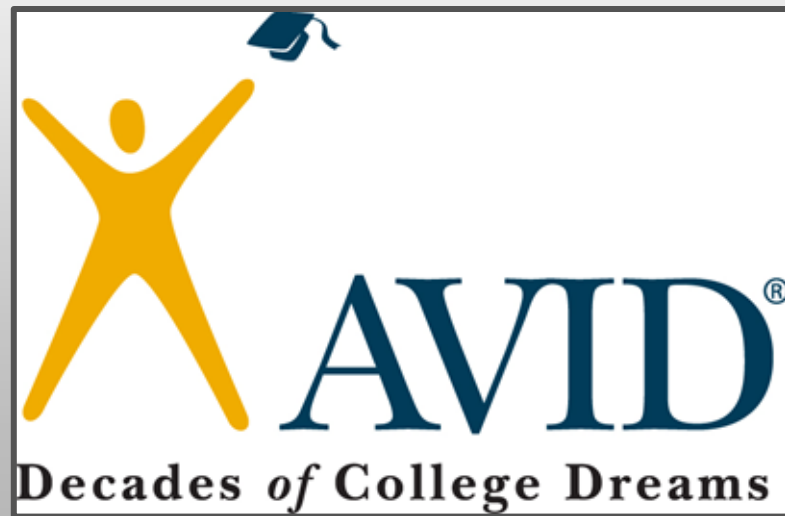

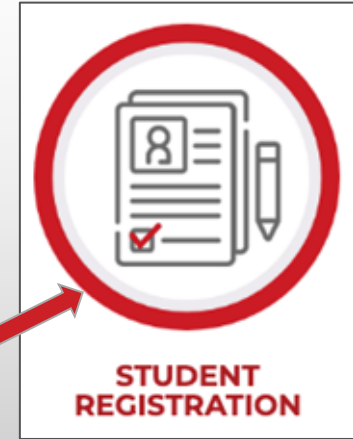

Registration Documentation



New families to District 120 are required to provide:

- Copy of the student's certified birth certificate
- Residency Verification - 2 forms
- If necessary, proof of court appointed custody
- School physical and dental exam
- Vision exam only for transfer students coming from out of state
- Medical forms (if applicable)

*Physical Exams and Dental Exams are required by the State of Illinois for all 9th grade students.

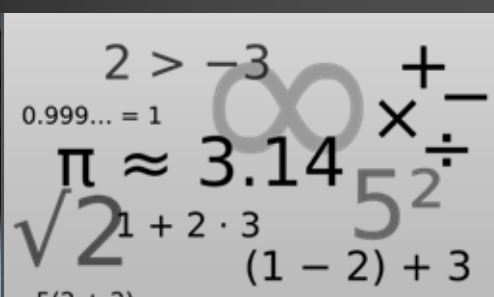

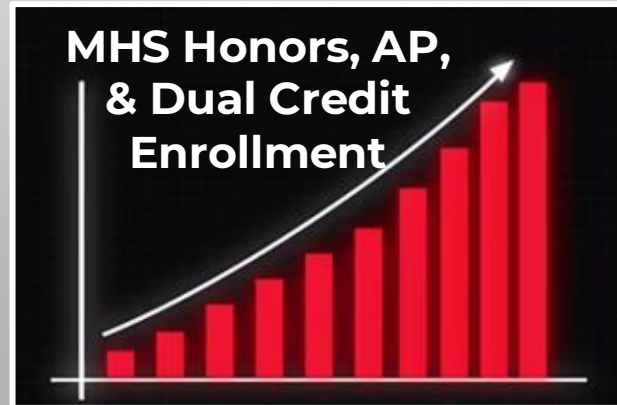

Earned Honors



- Students can earn honors credit in English 1, Biology, and World Studies.
- In order to earn honors in these three classes, students will need to demonstrate honors level achievement on the course assessments.
- Earned honors is only for these freshman courses. Beginning sophomore year, we offer separate advanced level courses: Honors English 2, Honors Chemistry, and Advanced Placement U.S. History.
- Freshmen can choose to take Advanced Placement Human Geography as an advanced level elective course.



Earned Honors

- **43% increase** in students taking AP exams over the past 5 years
- 84.5% of students who took an AP exam last spring received a **passing score= college credit**
- Over a 50% increase in **dual credit** enrollment with 96% of students receiving college credit
- 98% of the Class of 2025 entering College of Lake County **met or exceeded** proficiency in reading and writing.

Spanish 1/French 1 → Students with no background in either language

Spanish 2 → Students who took Spanish in middle school

Spanish for Heritage Learners 2 → Students who can speak Spanish, but cannot read or write in the language

Honors Spanish for Heritage Learners 3 → Students who can speak, read, and write in Spanish

Honors Spanish Language Arts 3 or 4 → Any student who was enrolled in a dual language program during middle school
