	<ul> <li>Stay home.</li> <li>If too sick to work, mark "COVID Unable to Work" in Frontline.</li> <li>If able to work, mark "COVID Able to Work" in Frontline.</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Quarantine for at least 10 days since the date you tested positive.</li> <li>Wait for clearance from the Lake County Health Department and/or your medical professional.</li> <li>Confirm with HR that you are cleared to return to work.</li> <li>If symptoms emerge, must stay home for 10 days since symptoms started AND 24 hours of no fever (without fever-reducing medication) AND symptom improvement.</li> </ul>	
	If you live with someone or are the caregiver for someone who tests positive your 14 day	
	<ul> <li>quarantine period starts at the end of the 10 day COVID positive individual's quarantine. This would be a total of 24 days.</li> <li>Notify supervisor and HR.</li> <li>The Principal will email building staff and contact potential close contacts.</li> <li>The Principal will notify cleaning staff of what rooms need to be deep cleaned.</li> </ul>
