DISTRICT 120 REPORT

2020 Estimated Property Tax Levy

Andy Searle reviewed the 2020 estimated property tax levy and the projected 2020 tax levy distribution. Prior to filing the final budget with Lake County a Public Hearing will be held at the next regularly scheduled board meeting in December. Discussion was held on the topic.

Basketball Update

Troy Parola reviewed the basketball issues between the Illinois High School Association (IHSA) and Illinois School Board Education (ISBE). He shared areas of concerns that the school districts have been addressing due to the state regulations related to the pandemic.

Hybrid Schedule Update

Mike Pope, Randy Lerner, Shane McCreery, Dr. Myers and Mr. Searle reviewed the proposed recommendations for the road to in-person instruction utilizing an AM/PM hybrid schedule versus the previously presented hybrid schedule. Discussion was held on the area of the cost for transportation. They also shared data on Lake County high school's remote, adaptive pause and hybrid plans; and current COVID metrics data.

In closing, Dr. Myers asked board members to approve a plan and to set a date for staff to return to the building.

Board members inquired on several areas of the proposed hybrid plans. They also agreed to support a hybrid plan that the administration would recommend for staff and students to return to the building.

Article 5, Memorandum of Understanding

Anthony Kroll reviewed that the MEA and administration have agreed to a Memorandum of Understanding regarding Article 5. The article addressed conditions created by the COVID19 pandemic for the 2020-22 MEA contract on the certificated employee evaluation. Board member Yaffe inquired if additional training is provided to certified staff members who need additional support.

2021-2022 Course Guide

Dr. Kroll reviewed the three additions to the 2021-2022 course guide. There were no alterations and/or deletions to the course guide.

School Board Policy 6:80, Second and Final Reading

Dr. Myers reviewed the recommendation made by the school district attorney to update school board policy 6:80.

School Board Policy 2:265, First Reading

Dr. Myers reviewed the recommendation to include additional and deleted language that was made by the school district attorney to update the school board policy.

Triple I Joint Virtual Conference Meeting

Dr. Myers asked board members attending the virtual conference meeting which panel sessions they would be attending. Board members also discussed the resolutions that will be presented at the delegate assembly.

Update New District Policy 7:12, Racial and Education Equity Development

Committee member Yaffe reviewed the recommendations to the proposed new district policy. Board members provided feedback on the recommendations. The committee members will also send the new district policy to the school district attorney for review. Committee members Yaffe and Mellon will present a first reading at the next regularly scheduled meeting.
