# **Vocabulary from the World of Damon Runyan**

According to Hoyle - in accordance with the accepted rules.

Bookie - slang for bookmaker; a person who accepts and handles bets on horse races.

Emily Post - author of a well-known source in all matters of manners or etiquette.

Fade - to meet the bet of an opposing player in dice.

Handicapper - a person who makes predictions on the outcomes of horse races.

Paint Cards - face cards—King, Queen, and Jack.

Major Domo - one who acts on behalf of or directs the affairs of others.

Make a Pass- a bet is placed as a "pass" when the shooter believes the sum total of the dice will be seven or eleven.

Morning Line - approximate odds printed on the program for a horse racetrack, and a prediction of how the wagering will go on a race.

Pimlico & Saratoga – horse racing tracks.

Roseland - a well-known ballroom in the 1950s.

Scratch Sheet - Horse racing stat sheets,

Snake Eyes - in gambling it is rolling two 1s. It is the lowest possible roll.

Sucker Bets - a sucker is a person easily cheated; therefore a sucker bet is a rip off bet.

Welch - to cheat by avoiding payment of a bet.

Your Dice - your roll; your turn.

# A Letter from the Mundelein Theatre Officers

We've had a great season at Mundelein Theatre, with seven incredible productions. The first official rehearsals of the 23/24 season began over the summer, with the annual Chicago Shakespeare Slam. The cast and Bard's Circle were tasked with reimagining the classic tale of Romeo and Juliet. The team performed live on the Chicago Shakespeare Theatre Stage, at Navy Pier, and earned first runner up in the competition. Before the first week of school ended, we got the ball rolling on our annual Student Directed One Acts. The show consisted of nine, 10-15-minute plays, each directed by a Mundelein Theatre senior. The shows were all very successful and a fun night for all who came to enjoy them. We revisited another classic story with our Fall Play, Lost Girl, in which after the dazzling adventures of their fantastical childhood, Wendy, Peter, and the Lost Boys are all forced to make peace with what it means to grow up. While the older members of our program were working on the fall play, the younger members were busy with their own production. With another nod to Shakespeare's Romeo and Juliet, our New Faces show this year was Becoming Juliet, the story of a financially struggling school pushing through obstacles to put on a production of the classic romance. The show was hilarious and heartfelt, giving the newer members of the Theatre program a chance to dive into the world of theatre, and take center stage. Middletown was our Winter Play and featured a principal cast as well as a full understudy cast. It started when a new resident moved into town, but when she befriends a long-term resident, she quickly discovers that below Middletown's honest exterior is something much more complex. *Middletown* is a very human portrayal of people who live two lives, one ordinary and visible, the other complicated and hidden. Concurrent with our winter play, Mundelein Theatre participated in the IHSA-sponsored event, Group Interpretation, a short-play competition that consists of the use of no costuming, props or any kind of special effects, and solely depends on the use of voice, movement, and space. This year, our team performed Chicago, a story that depicts betrayal, heartbreak, and the effects of both positive and negative publicity. The team portrayed all aspects of the show wonderfully, and we were endlessly proud of their work. We now end this fantastic season with our production of the classic musical fable of Broadway, Guys and Dolls. The musical follows gamblers Sky Masterson and Nathan Detroit in their complex relationships with the important women in their lives, Sarah Brown and Miss Adelaide. With these larger-than-life characters, we plan on bringing you a down to earth and real story about the change that true love can bring. We hope to breathe new life into this classic musical.




