CALENDAR

Please note that in 2026-27, due to a massive construction project happening at Mundelein High School, the students will be starting the year far later than in the past. Their first day will be September 8th, which will push final exams for first semester back until January 29th. For this reason mid-year transcripts will **not be available** until the second week of February, 2027. Similarly, our final transcripts will **not be available** until the end of June or potentially early July if we require use of emergency days throughout the year.

OUR SCHOOL

Mundelein High School is a comprehensive one-building district for grades 9-12. The district covers a 36-square-mile area and serves the needs of 2066 students from Mundelein and surrounding communities. Mundelein is on Chicago's North Shore, about 40 miles north of Chicago. Roughly 86.5 percent of graduates in the class of 2026 chose to continue their education at postsecondary institutions.

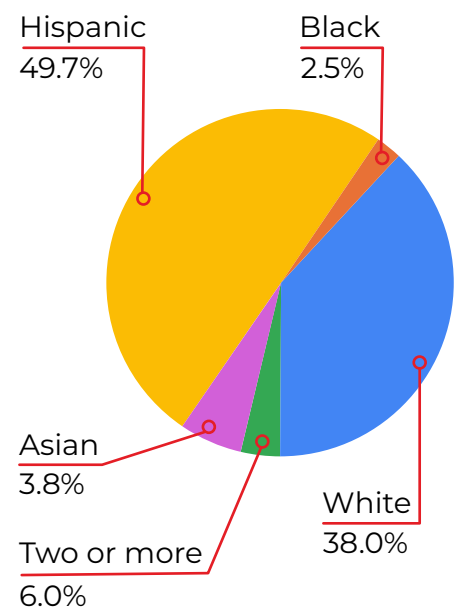

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Students graduating in the class of 2027 will need a total of 22 credits to earn their diploma. In addition, students need to pass the Illinois Constitution Examination.
