Philosophy Club: CLUB BYLAWS

Article I. Philosophy Club

The Philosophy Club is **a MHS CLUB**, hereafter referred to as the club.

Article II. Purpose of the Club

- 1. Allow students to participate in informative discussions on a number of philosophical topics.
- 2. Provide a positive forum in which students can be creative, innovative, and provide opportunities to serve their community in their prospective area of interests.

Article III. Membership

- 1. Membership is open to any currently enrolled Mundelein High School student interested in philosophy.
- 2. Only students who have been in the club a minimum of one year are allowed to run for club offices.
- 3. Current members may bring up new business, concerns or ideas during the open floor session of regularly scheduled meetings.

Article IV. Officer Positions

- 1. The officers of this club shall be President and Vice President. Officer positions may be deleted or established by a majority vote of the club.
- 2. Officers will be elected for one year by a vote of the club at the beginning of each school year.
- 3. Officers cannot miss more than one meeting per term. Once a second mtg. is missed by the president, the positions of vice-president and president are switched.

Article V. Officer Duties

 President - principal officer and is responsible for leading the club in meetings along with the sponsor and activities in accordance with guidelines established by the Mundelein High School administrators and these bylaws. 2. Vice President - shall assist the president in club management, shall preside over club meetings in the absence of the president, and shall perform other duties assigned by the president.

Article VI. Faculty Sponsors

- 1. The faculty sponsors are Mrs. Michele Bonadies and Mrs. Susan Theotokatos
- 2. The sponsor must be present at all club meetings.
- 3. The sponsor will be responsible for supervising elections and maintaining order within the club.
- 4. A sponsor will work closely with the club officers in business matters of the club including keeping the website for the club current.

Article VIII. Voting

- 1. Each member may vote.
- 2. All proposed changes (amendments) to these bylaws must be approved by a majority of the club.

Article IX. Meetings

- 1. General meetings will be held monthly. Meeting locations and times are subject to change by a consensus of the club's officers and space availability.
- 2. A sponsor is required to attend each meeting.
- 3. Minutes and attendance will be taken during all meetings.
- 4. Minutes will be submitted to the Assistant Principal at the end of each term.
