

## **Steven's Amendment**

When our district is audited by the State Board of Education for federal grants, we are asked if we meet the requirements of the Steven's Amendment (Public Law 101-166). The Steven's Amendment is public law that requires that when issuing statements, press releases, requests for proposals, bid solicitations and other documents describing projects or programs funded in whole or in part with Federal money, that we describe the: percentage of the total costs of the program or project which will be financed with Federal money, the dollar amount of the total costs of the project or program that will be financed by nongovernmental sources.

In order to place our district into a status of compliance, I would like to share with you the amount of federal grant money that we receive for programs.
