### ACT Resources

- Each year, the Illinois State Board of Education requires all Illinois public school students to take the ACT in 11th grade as a graduation requirement. Students in 9th and 10th grade are required to take the PreACT 9 and PreACT 10 to build familiarity with ACT-style content and the assessment format. On April 8 or 9, MHS freshmen, sophomores, and juniors will take the appropriate assessment.

- Summer school gives students the opportunity to stay on track for graduation and, in some cases, to create greater flexibility in their school-year schedules. For students who need to recover credits, summer credit recovery offers a structured online program led by teachers to complete required coursework and stay on track for graduation.
