Article I

Black Student Union

Article II

-Providing charitable assistance within the community such as Habitat for Humanity and Feed my Starving Children.

-Influencing the members to strive for excellence in academics, athletics, and activities.

-Provides opportunities for college and career exploration and experiences.

Article III

- Membership is open to any current Mundelein High School student.

- Only currently enrolled students are allowed to run for club offices.

- Members must attend a minimum of 3 regularly scheduled meetings as a condition for attending an out-of-school activity/trip. This stipulation is reset after each activity/trip.

- Current members may bring up new business during meetings, or through other communication channels.

Article IV

- Officer positions for Black Student Union consist of a president, vice president, events coordinator, and secretary.

- Officers will be elected for one school year

Article V

- BSU President- is responsible for leading the club in meetings and activities in accordance with guidelines established by Mundelein High School administrators and these bylaws.

- Vice President- shall assist the president in club management, shall preside over club meetings in the absence of the president, and shall perform other duties assigned by the president.

- Event Coordinator- shall promote and run events held by Black Student Union.

- Shall create and maintain a dynamic website for the club.

- If the President isn't able to fulfill his/her duties, the vice president shall take his/her place.
- If the Vice President(s) isn't able to fulfill his/her duties, an event coordinator most suited for the job, shall take his/her place.
- If at any moment the event coordinator(s) or webmaster isn't able to fulfill their duties, everyone in BSU must vote for new people to take the positions.

Article VI

- There must be a faculty sponsor(s).
- A sponsor will be responsible for supervising elections and maintaining order within the club.

Article VII

- The executive council will be composed of all club officers and sponsors.
- The executive council will meet weekly to plan the agenda and to make club decisions that do not need a majority vote of all club members.
- Meetings will be called as necessary.

Article VIII

- Each member may vote.
- All proposed changes to these bylaws must be approved by majority of the club and sponsor.

Article IX

- General meetings will be held every Friday.

Article X

- The content of Black Student Union website may include, but is not limited to:
 - o Links
 - o MHS Program Info
 - o Communications Log

- Items and links on the website will adhere to all Mundelein High School District policies.

Article XI

- All members will adhere to the Mundelein High School Activity Code of Conduct.
- The club shall operate under current school policy.

Article XII

- Articles in this set of bylaws may be deleted or modified as deemed necessary by a majority of the club and sponsor.
