Uniforms - Marching

- No physical gift cards were ordered this month

Miscellaneous:

- Music Camp Scholarships – we will still offer this to students but checks will be disbursed as a reimbursement instead of up front as it has been in the past. Band directors will send email to families with details on how to apply for the scholarships.
- Evening of Jazz will likely be cancelled. In the event that we do go back to school in May, we may have a concert and maybe host a 50/50 raffle instead of the baskets
- Memorial Day Parade and Kracklauer are both up in the air at this point

Directors Updates:

- Many donations for the Invitational (which was cancelled) were returned. As for the registration fees that participating bands paid, they were given the options to 1) carry over for next year's Invitational; 2) receive a refund; 3) make a donation to the guest artists who were supposed to perform at the Invitational and many of the bands chose to make the donation.
- MHS band was selected for Super State this year, however, the festival was cancelled, so it's been a disappointment. It's an honor to be selected, so boosters are considering doing something for all the students, maybe a sweatshirt or t-shirt to reflect the achievement. Perhaps a banner in the band room?
- In the fall we may have Ray (Concerto winner) participate in one of the concerts so that he will have the opportunity to play his winning piece
