**Past Events:**

- Virtual camps (Drum Major Camp, Marching Band Camp, Color Guard Camp, Percussion Camp) – all camps have been taken online this summer and the students are finding creative and meaningful ways to make the most of the virtual learning environment. All student leaders have really stepped up to find ways to make connections.
- Mr. Sturgeon shared a slideshow introducing the staff at MHS for Band as well as the student leaders for this year, including drum majors, field captains, freshman liaisons and librarians.
- The field captains this year have put together a video series on marching; this should be especially helpful for incoming freshman.

**Treasurer (Greg Shumski)**

- Bank balances as of 7/31/2020 Statements:
  - Boosters: \$24,843.39
  - Escrow: \$22,935.55
- Updates and Highlights:
  - General:
    - Pie Card Fundraiser – we still need a new one to replace this one
    - State of Illinois Tax Exemption – we have not received any response from the state. Due to COVID there are delays and extensions, so as of now we believe the exemption is fine through December 31, 2020
    - Escrow and Boosters reimbursement forms have been updated on the website

- Escrow:
  - Senior class donations to boosters so far \$633.38
  - Scrips deposits for June \$146.80

#### **Miscellaneous:**

- Greg Shumski reviewed a table that he put together with information from past years fundraising efforts, including percentages distributed as well as profits made
- Nicole Knight expressed interest in leading Fundraising
- Question was raised on how to sign up for Scrips. Greg Shumski and Kristine Asmussen will review and send out information about the Scrips program to all band families
- Question was raised whether there will be a marching season in the spring when Football season takes place – Mr. Sturgeon explained that as of now many things are still uncertain and that we won't know the answer until spring
- Suggestion was made to continue dine out events during the year since the summer ones were pretty successful

#### **Directors Updates:**

- Mr. Sturgeon and Mr. Shelato did a demo of a program called Sound Trap to record music with other people so that parents could see how the students will be making recordings “together” this year
- Boxes have arrived at the school containing the new marching band uniforms
