

# DIVERSITY CLUB BYLAWS

## Article I.

### Diversity Club

## Article II.

- Promoting an environment of tolerance and acceptance through club education and MHS school-wide campaigns.
- Celebrating diversity through school events, such as the Cultural Fair.
- Providing charitable assistance to people in need, such as the Red Cross Philippines disaster relief.

## Article III.

- Membership is open to any current Mundelein High School student.
- Only currently enrolled students are allowed to run for club offices.
- Currents members may bring up new business during meetings and propose new units of study and action.

## Article IV.

- Officer positions for Diversity Club consist of a president and vice president, secretary and public relations officer.
- Officers will be elected for one year.

Article V.

- President- principal officer and is responsible for leading the club in meetings and activities in accordance with guidelines established by Mundelein High School administrators and these bylaws.
- Vice President- shall assist the president in club management, shall preside over club meetings in the absence of the president, and shall perform other duties assigned by the president.
- If the President isn't able to fulfill his/her duties, the vice president shall take his/her place.
- If the Vice President(s) isn't able to fulfill his/her duties, the Secretary will take his/her place
- Secretary- will help maintain club meeting minutes and support the president/vice president as needed.
- Public Relations Officer- is responsible for producing promotional materials for the club including posters, announcements and managing the image of awareness campaigns.

Article VI.

- There must be a faculty sponsor(s).
- A sponsor will be responsible for supervising elections and maintaining order within the club.

Article VII.

- The executive committee will be composed of all club officers and sponsors.
- The executive committee will meet as required to make club decisions that do not need a majority vote of all club members.
- Meetings will be called as necessary.

Article VIII.

- Each member may vote.
- All proposed changes to these bylaws must be approved by majority of the club and sponsor.

Article IX.

- General meetings will be held every other week or as necessary.

Article X.

- Members of Diversity Club must participate in any activities being held by Diversity Club.

Article XI.

- The content of Diversity Club's website may include, but is not limited to:
  - o Units of study
  - o Links
  - o Event information
  - o MHS Program Info
  - o Communications Log
- Items and links on the website will adhere to all Mundelein High School District policies.

Article XII.

- All members will adhere to the Mundelein High School Activity Code of Conduct.
- The club shall operate under current school policy.

Article XIII.

- Articles in this set of bylaws may be deleted or modified as deemed necessary by a majority of the club and sponsor.
